Our senior students and our first graders were the first to experience the new ride. Principal Burrows took them on a short trip out of the gate and into the courtyard.



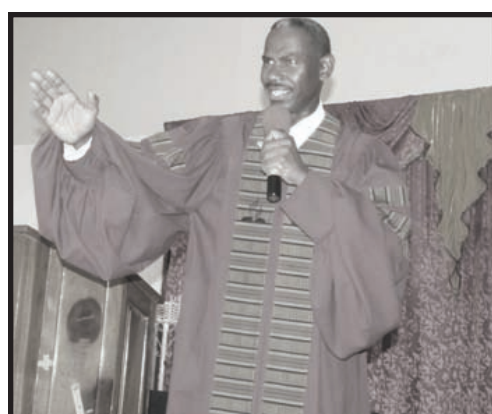
